where they work**



## **If I have worked in more than one country**

**If I have worked in several countries, International Social Security agreements are applied to the following benefits:**


- **disability**
- **old age**
- **survivors**
- **death**
- **unemployment**
- **accident at work**
- **sickness**
- **maternity**
- **family**




## **If I return to my country**

**In the case of repatriation, non-EU people who have worked in Italy with fixed term or open-ended contracts keep their social security rights.**

### **Old age Pension**




**Non-EU workers,  
hired after 1 Jan.  
1996, are eligible for  
an Old Age pension  
at the age of 65  
regardless of normal  
requirements**



**On the date of 31<sup>st</sup> of  
December 1995, if you  
have 20 years of  
contributions, you will  
be eligible for an INPS  
Old Age pension at the  
age of 65 for both  
women and men.**


