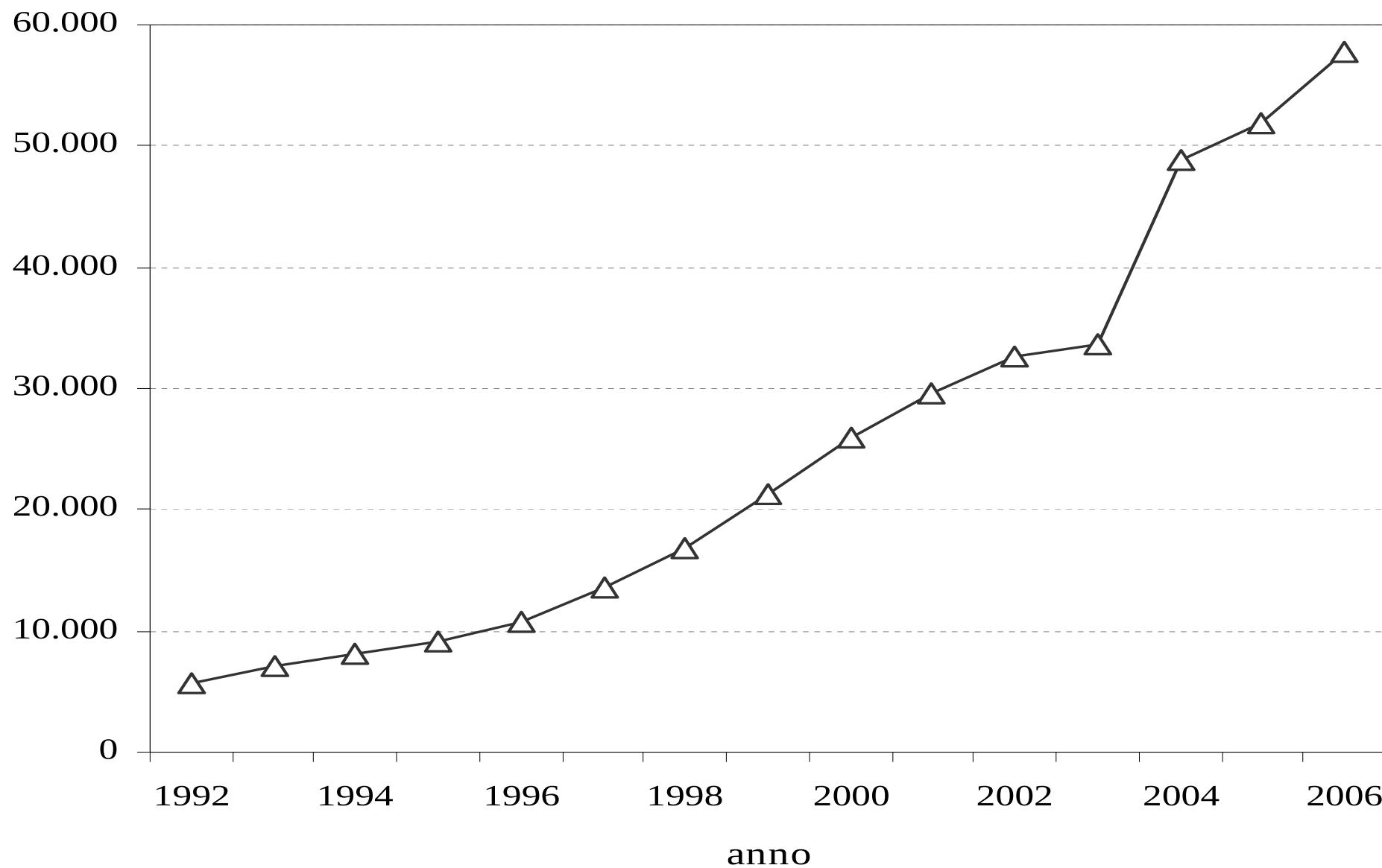

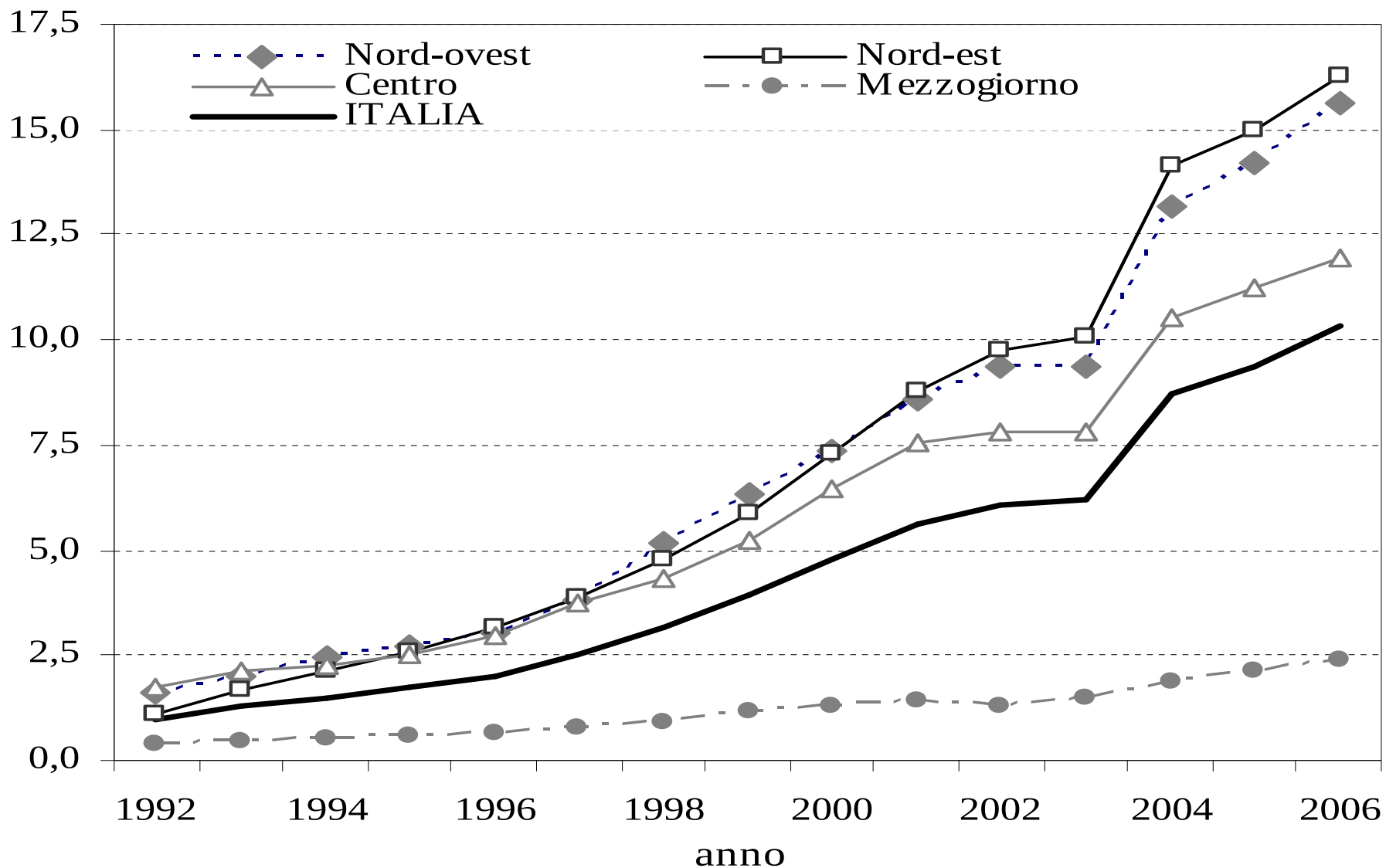
Foreign births in Italy, 1992-2006



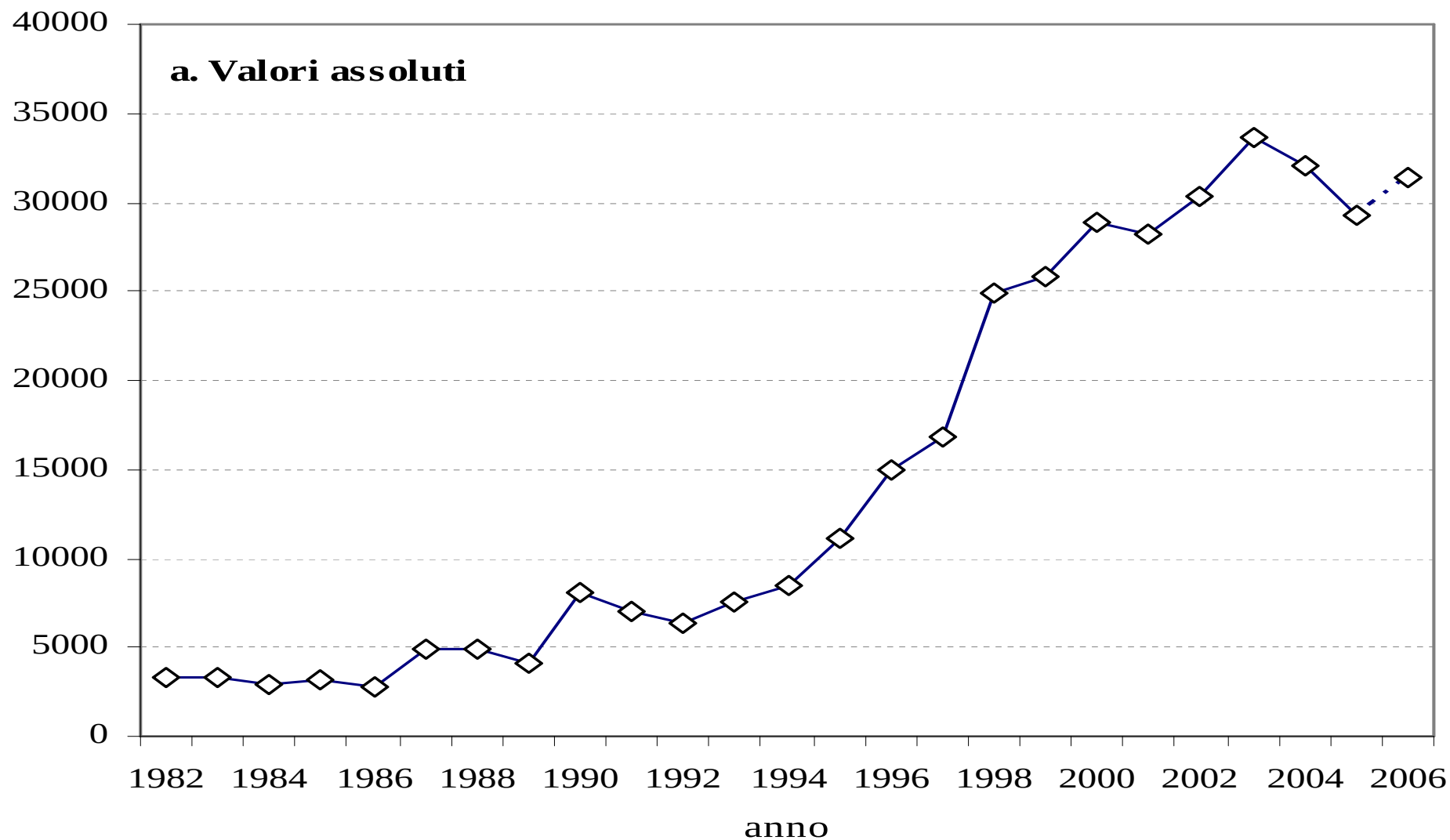

Italia, 1992-2006**



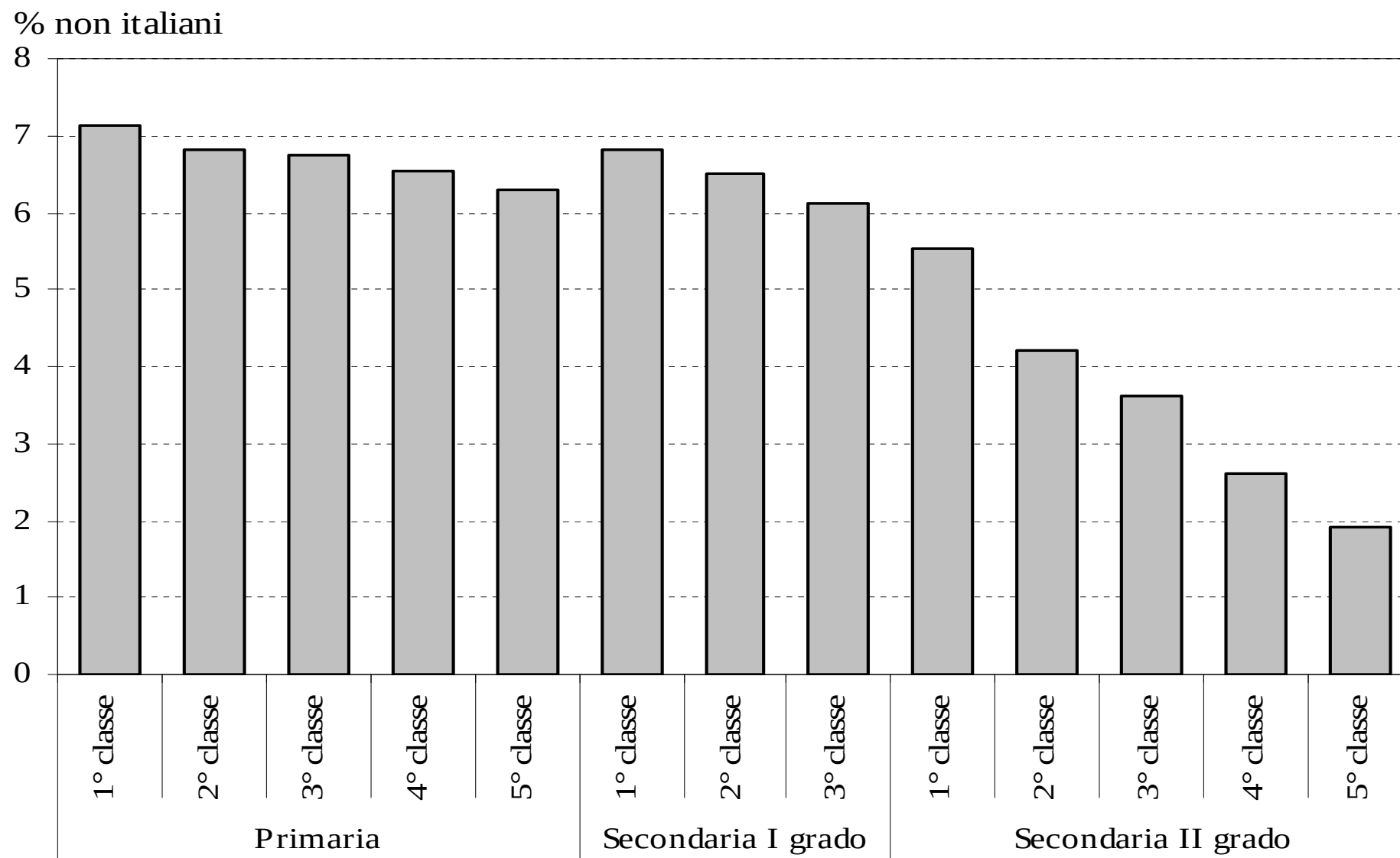
New immigrants 15 year old or less. Italia, 1982-2005

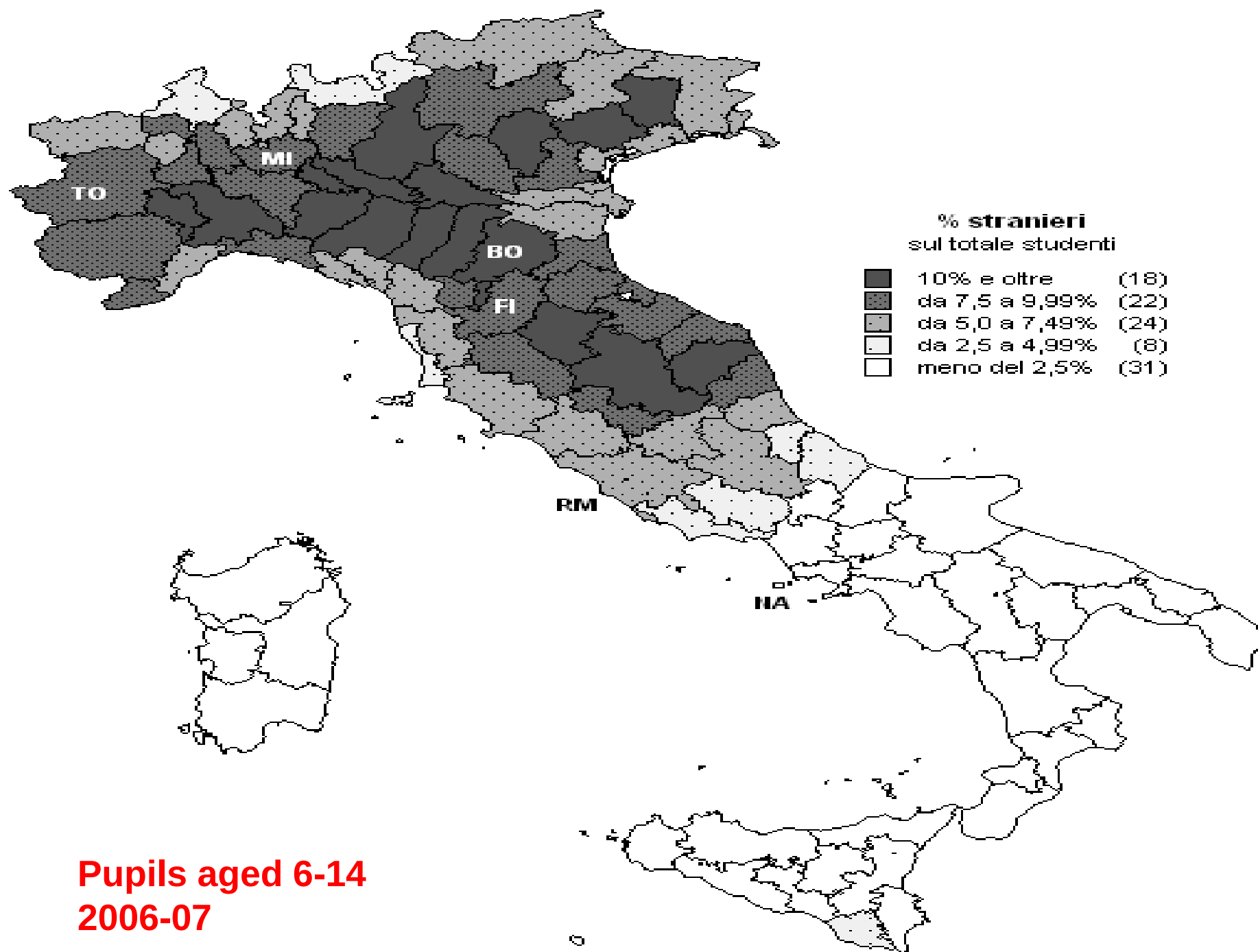

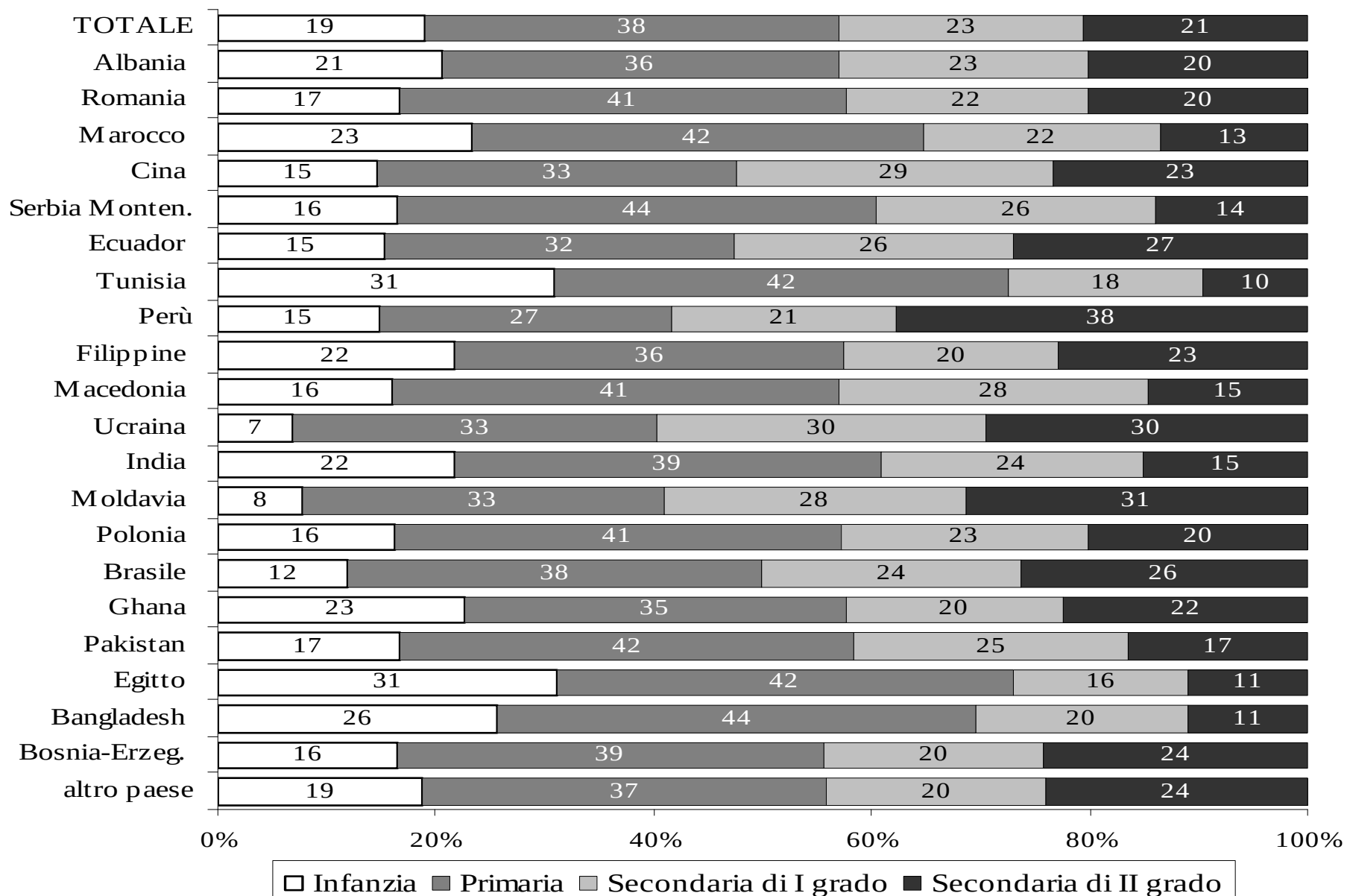
% Foreigners in Italian schools by class. Italy, 2006-07



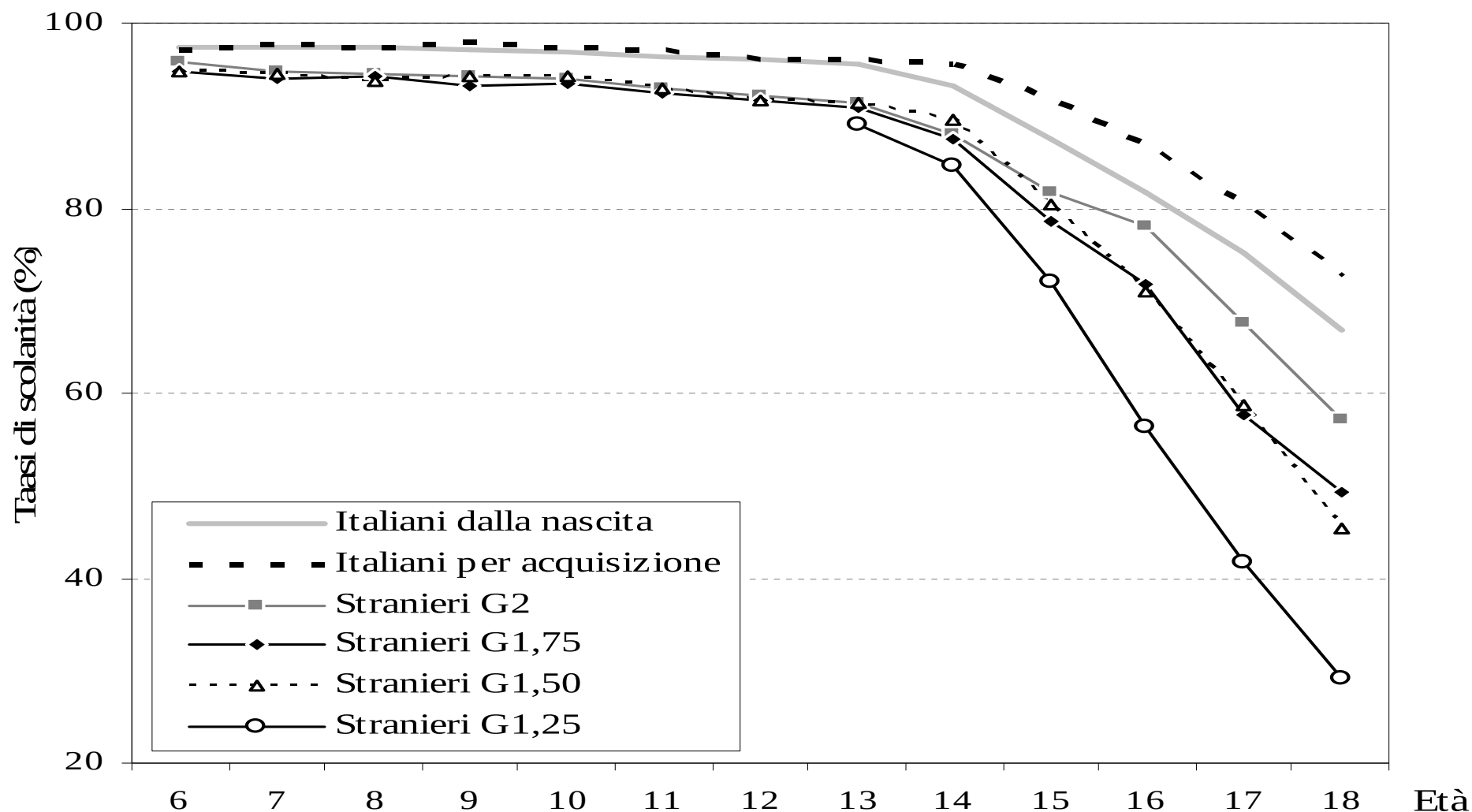

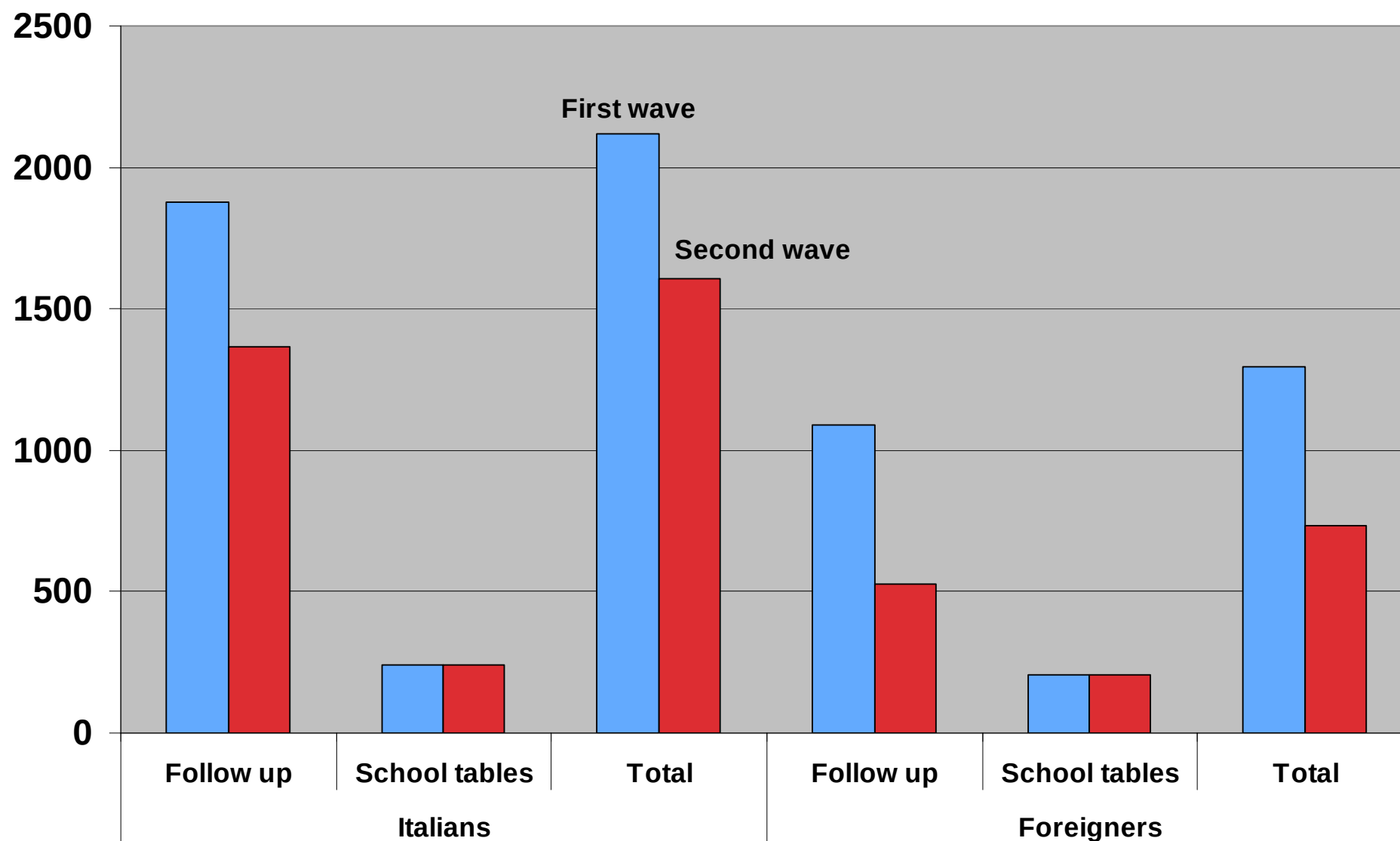


Sampling Survey ITAGEN2

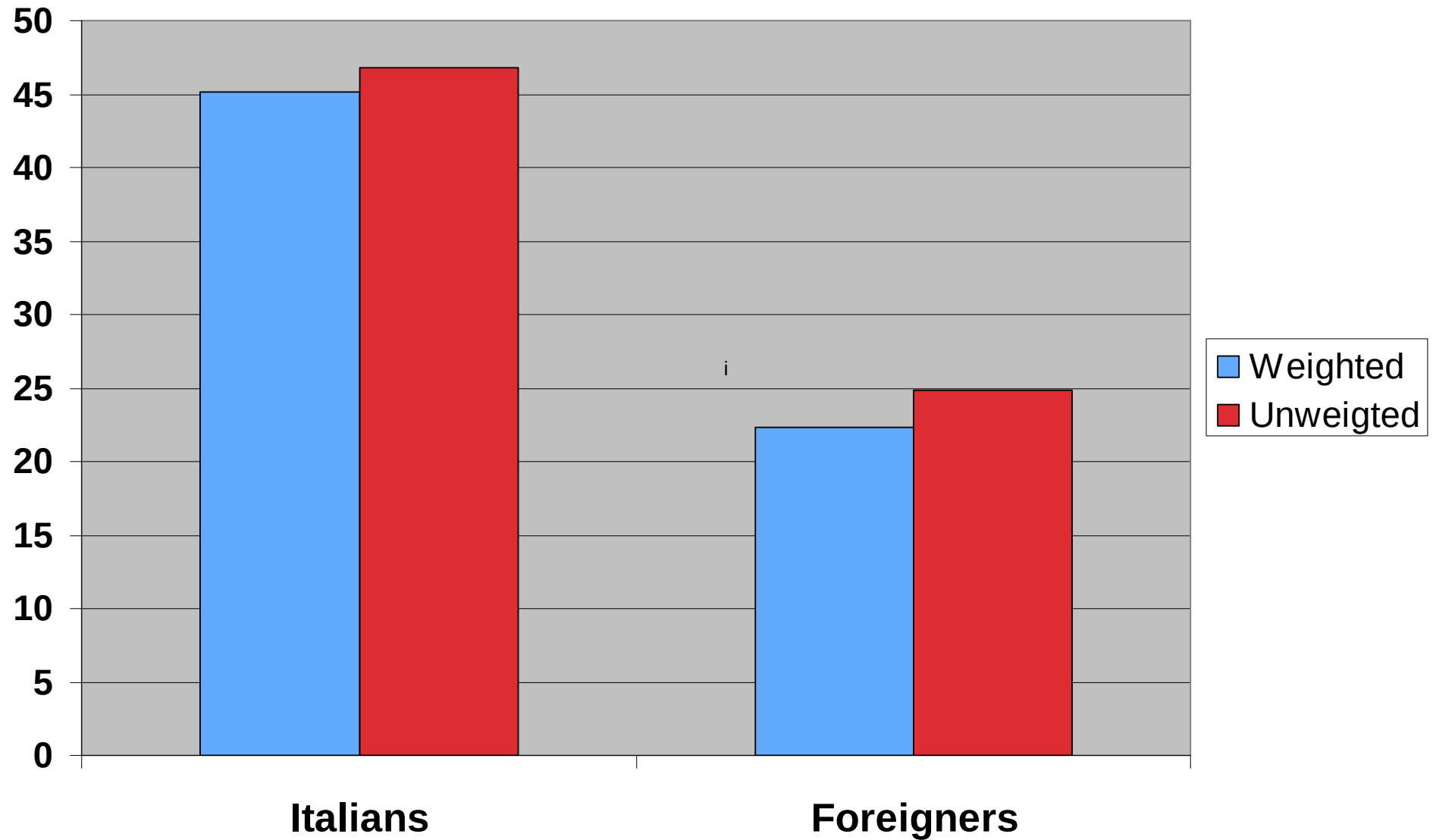
- Quantitative
- Targeted on Junior High Schools (age 10-14)
- Statistically representative of 48 provinces for schools with >10% foreign pupils (CN) and >3% (Sol)
- Self-filled questionnaire
- Comparison between Italians and foreigners
- Large numbers (about 10,000 foreigners and 10,000 Italians). More than 200 schools involved
- Panel in Veneto (Vicenza and Padova), Marche, Sicily-Calabria, Apulia (about 3,000), collecting names and phone numbers



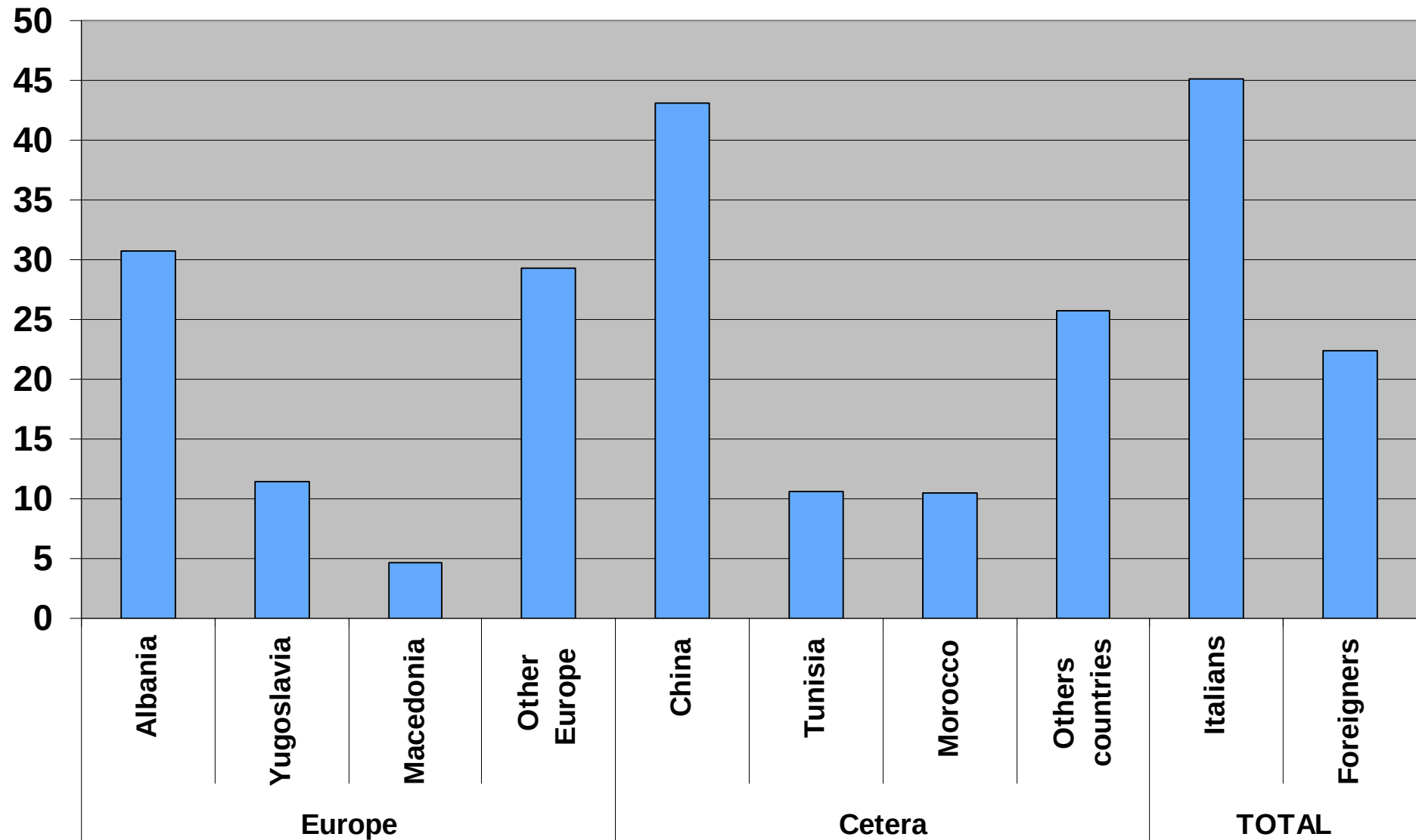
Performance of second wave (first months of 2008) and additional data on school results



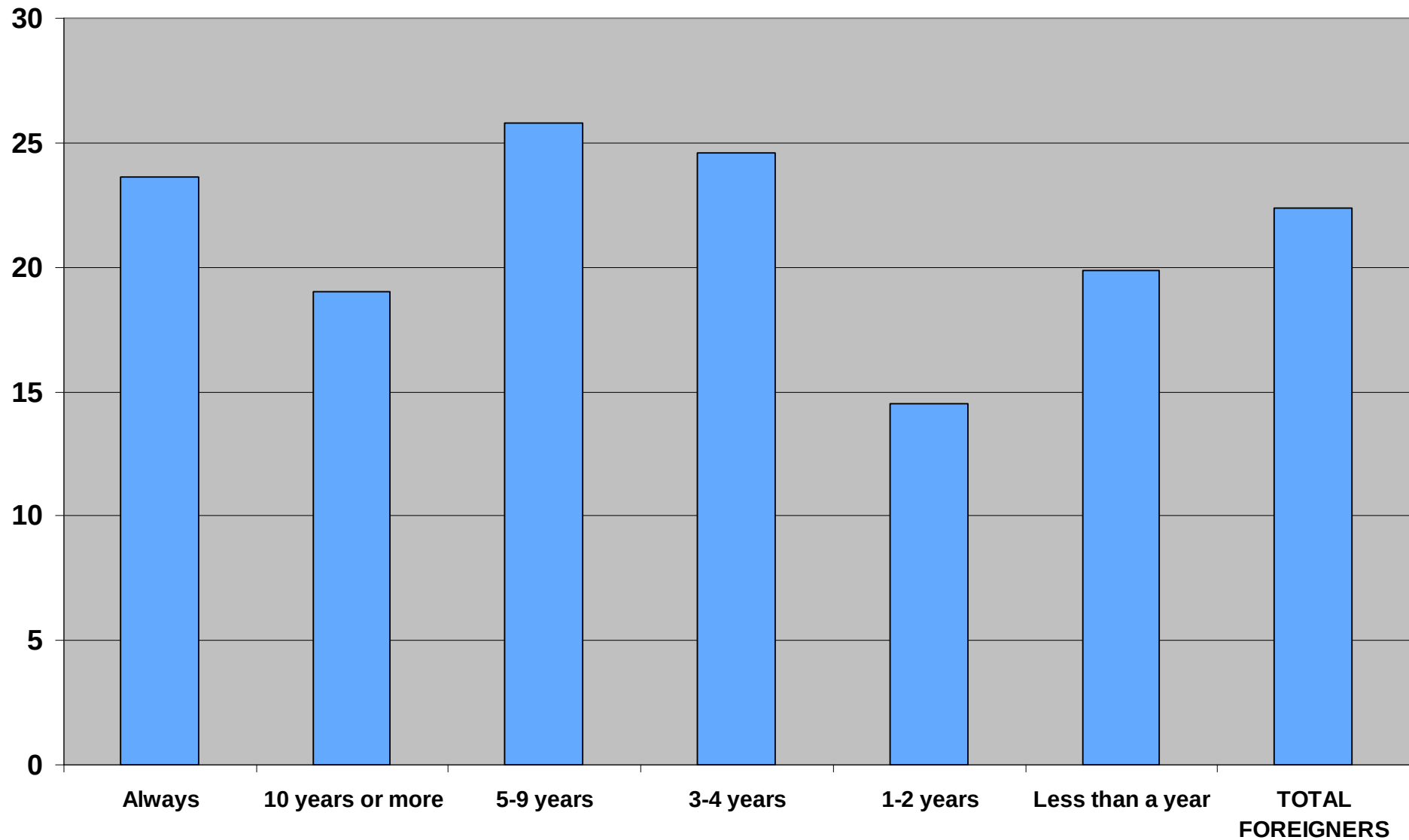
% GOOD (Ottimo & Distinto)



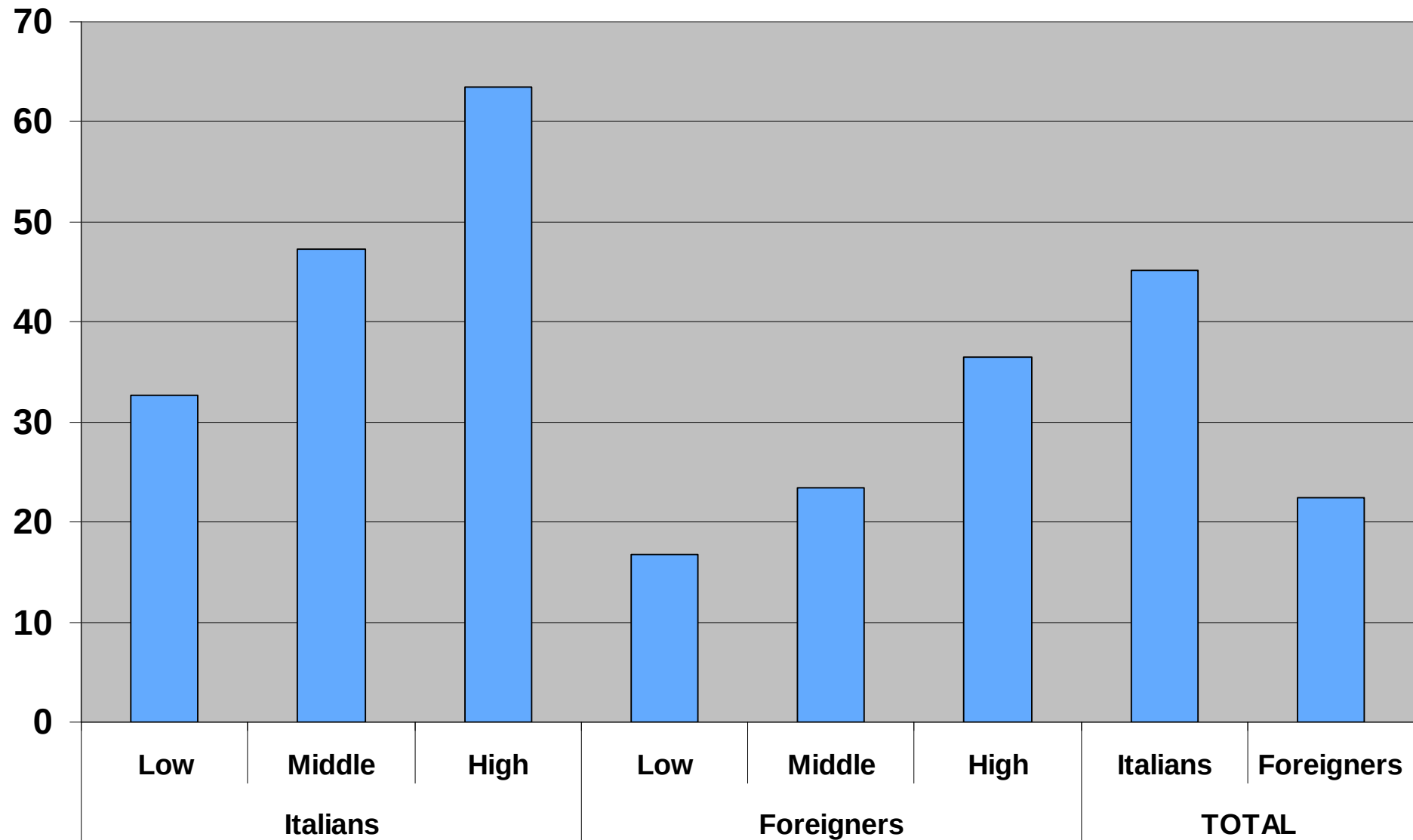
% GOOD: place of birth of parents



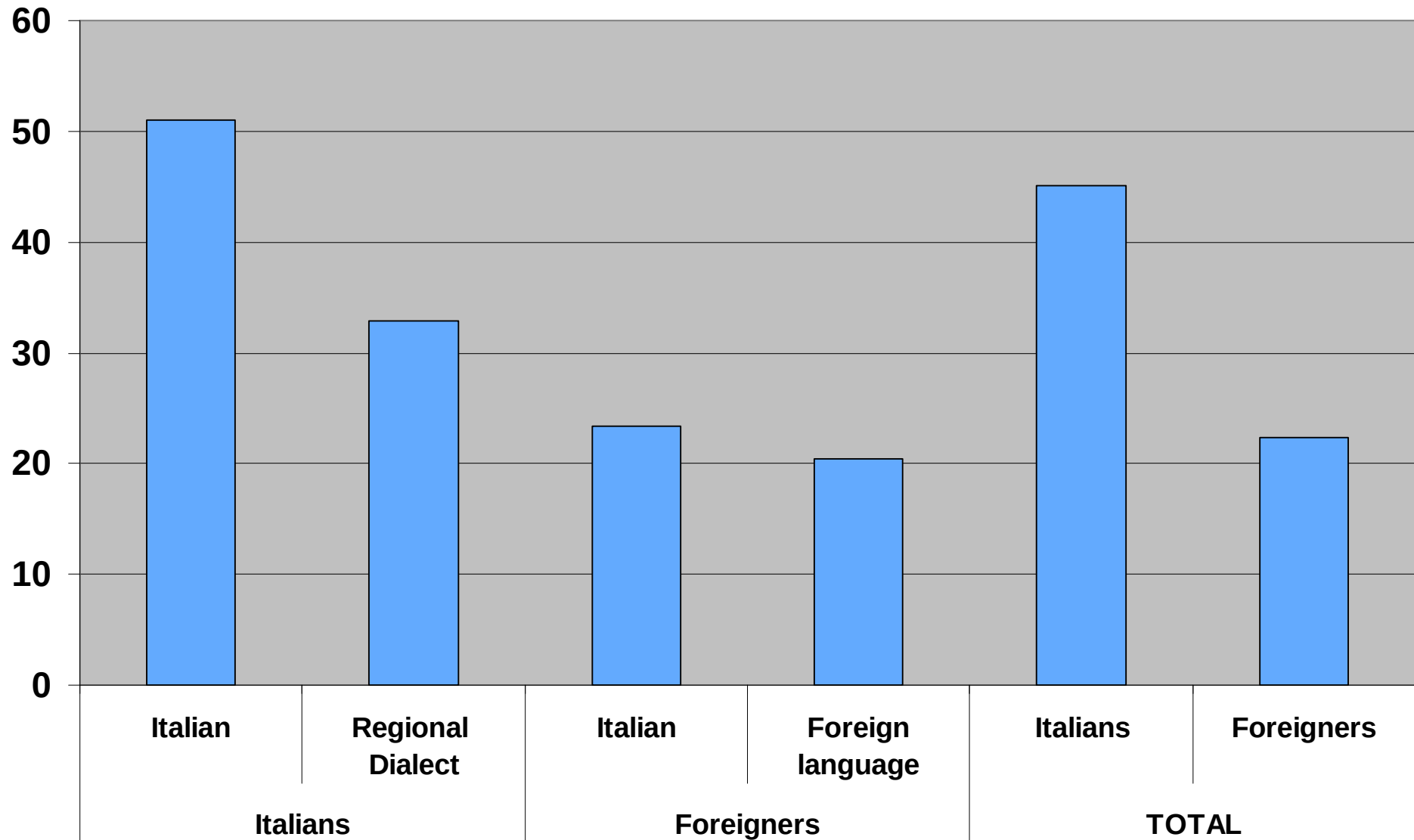
% GOOD by period spent in Italy



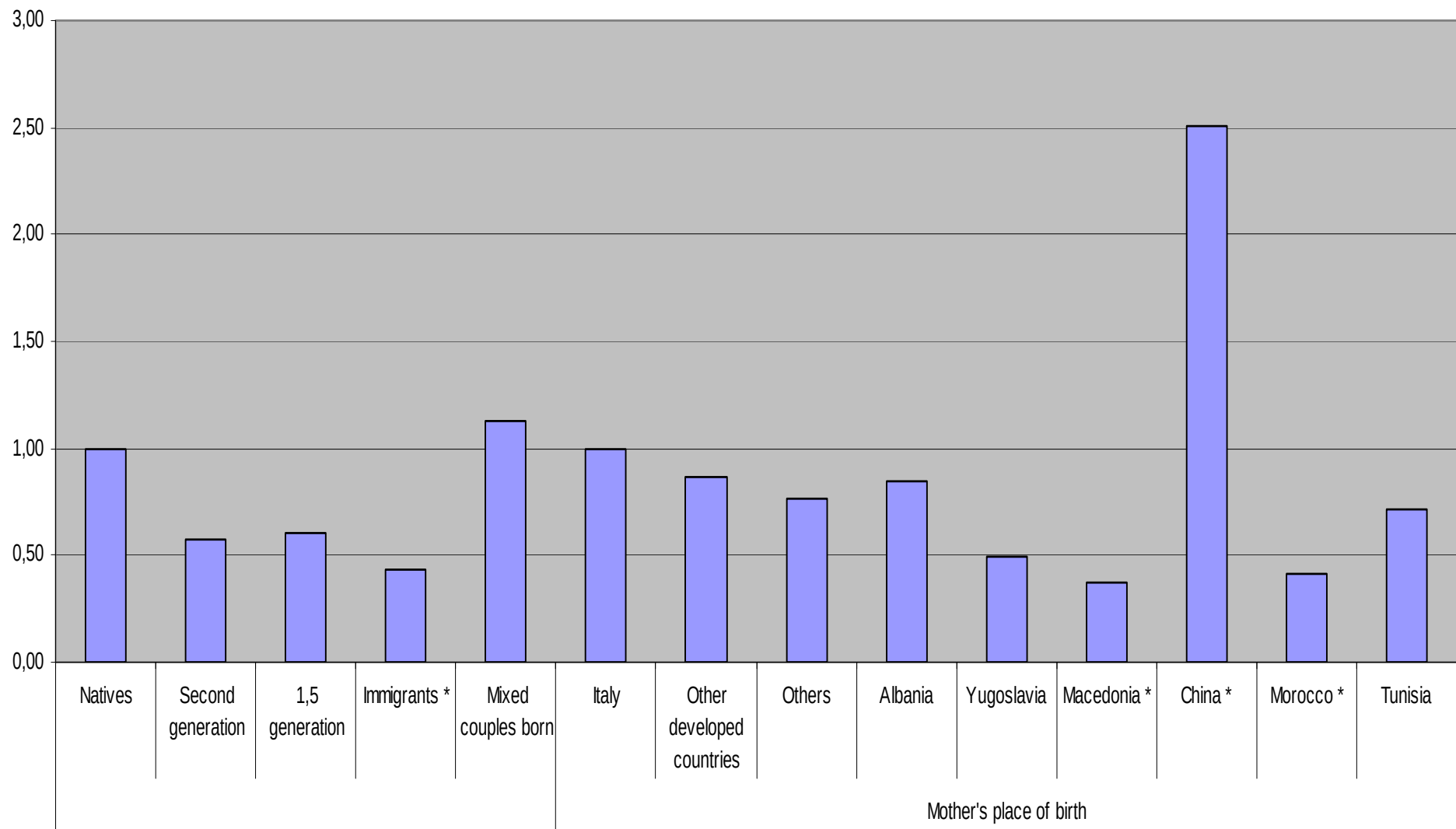
% GOOD by education of parents
